DESCRIPTION

A high performing, densely tillered, late heading (+20 days) diploid Enhanced perennial ryegrass. High year-round growth rates including strong cool season performance, high in pasture quality (ME, digestibility) and palatability, with very good persistence and disease resistance. Available in standard endophyte.

WHERE IT FITS

Sequel is a high performance grass suited to farmers who want a reliable high producing perennial ryegrass which will persist well, even under moderate pressure from top-feeding insect pests. Sequel is best suited to rotational grazing under dairy, beef and sheep grazing systems.
