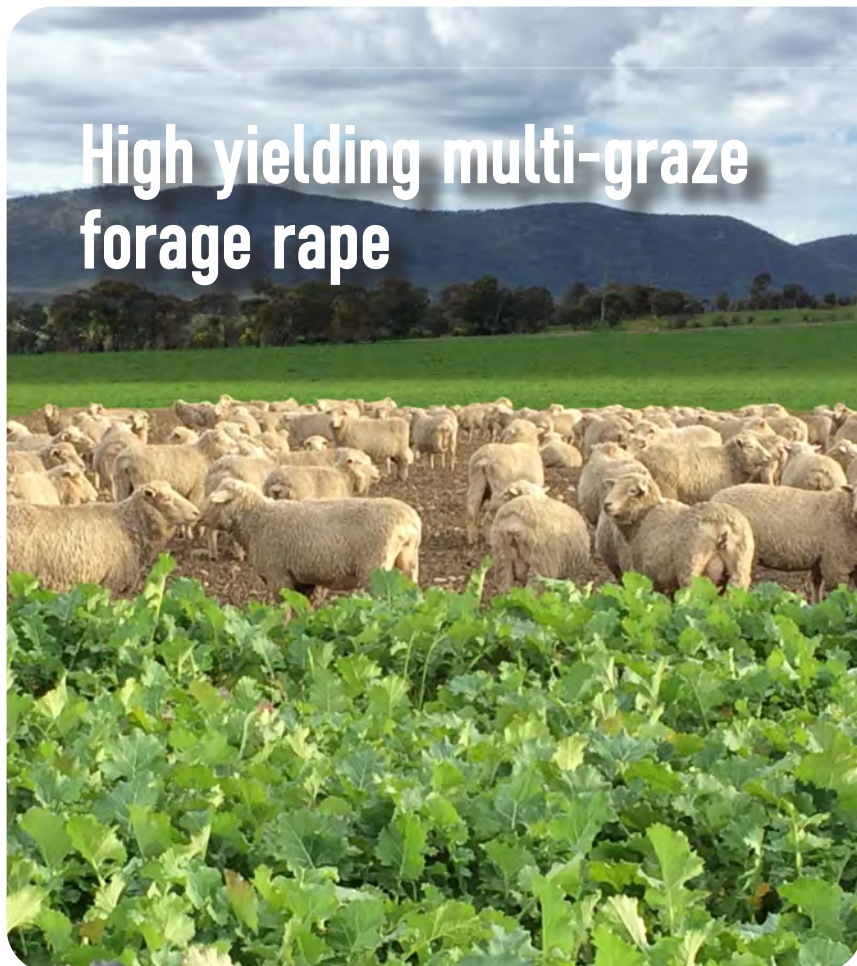
FORAGE RAPE

A fast establishing, high yielding, multi-graze giant-type forage rape with strong re-growth potential and good disease resistance.

Pillar is a modern forage rape, developed for our farming conditions. It can be used as a multi-graze forage crop, sown in either spring or autumn to provide fast establishing summer or autumn/winter feed. Pillar is suitable for all livestock types and farming systems and is an ideal break crop as part of a pasture renovation programme.

Agronomic traits

- **Sowing season:** Spring or Autumn
- **Maturity (days to graze):** 80-110
- **Number of grazings:** 2-4*
- **Aphid tolerance:** Moderate - good
- **Minimum rainfall (mms):** 600+ or irrigated
- **Disease resistance:** Good
- **Sowing rate (kg/ha):** 3-4
