

# DASH

## ANNUAL RYEGRASS

A fast establishing, late heading, densely tillered and high yielding tetraploid annual ryegrass with big bold leaves.

Dash is quick out of the ground, with rapid re-growth and excellent winter growth activity. Dash holds on well into the spring, offering great flexibility for late season fodder conservation or extra grazings.



### Agronomic traits

- **Heading date:** Late
- **Persistence:** 8-10 months\*
- **Growth peak:** autumn-spring
- **Sowing season:** autumn
- **Sowing rate:** 25-30 (kg/ha)
