- Consistently high yield and cool season performance

- Late heading (+26 days) for carrying pasture quality longer into spring
- Very low aftermath heading (returns to vegetative state quickly after heading)

- ▶ Ideal for use as a short term, high quality feed, or for over-sowing into damaged or run-out pastures to extend their life



LATE HEADING DATE

RELATIVE HEADING DATE:

Vibe's very late heading date promotes improved leaf to stem ratio and allows high nutritive value to be maintained throughout spring and into summer.

HOLDS FORAGE QUALITY FOR LONGER INTO SPRING
