


SW6330

LUCERNE

SW6330 is a semi-winter active lucerne flexible for both cutting and grazing. Suited to the majority of New Zealand regions it has strong spring to autumn dry matter production and is suitable for all livestock types. SW6330 produces very high quality feed and has strong tolerance to many common lucerne pests and diseases.



Agronomic traits

- › Winter dormancy: 6
- › Persistence: 5+ years
- › Suitability: Grazing and cutting
- › Pest & disease tolerance: Strong
- › Sowing rate (grazing): 12-18kg/ha
- › Sowing rate (Hay): 15-20kg/ha

Pest & disease resistance

- › Bacterial Wilt: Resistant
- › Fusarium Wilt: Resistant
- › Phytophthora Root Rot: Resistant
- › Spotted Alfalfa Aphid: Resistant
- › Blue Alfalfa Aphid: Moderate resistance
- › Stem Nematode: Moderate resistance
