With a semi-erect to erect growth habit and mid-season flowering, Vision is a high-yielding cocksfoot, demonstrating strong growth across all seasons. Its finer stem and leaf form, coupled with a not excessively dense growth habit, make it compatible with other grasses and clover. Vision eliminates the risk of grass staggers and heat stress while showcasing strong insect tolerance, including against Grass Grub and Porina. Vision is a cost effective dryland option either sown or broadcast over extensive pastoral areas.
